



Leadership Volunteer Role Descriptions

Race Operations - Raymond Field

Start/Finish Line Lead

In this role, you will oversee the Raymond Field set up and tear down. You will also make sure all volunteers know what their job for the day is. This could include:

- Setting up water station
- Signage
- Supporting youth races
- Medal presenter

You will be the main point of contact for these volunteers.

Water Station Lead

In this role, you will be assigned a group of water stations along the course. You will be the point of contact for your section of water stations. In the event a volunteer expresses a water station is low on supplies, any questions about set up, they will reach out to you for help. This role is best suited for problem solvers with a calm disposition!

Pace Lead

In this role, you will be responsible for maintaining a steady pace and providing continuous support to participants as they strive towards the finish line, all the while offering motivational encouragement. The pace leader will establish a consistent speed, allowing the participants to ease their mind and stay in sync with the designated pace.

Are you an experienced and enthusiastic runner with a passion for motivating others to achieve their goals? This is the role for you!

Cycle Lead

In this role, you will help recruit cyclists for the various races on race weekend. Cyclists need leaders for each race and specific time intervals. Prior to race weekend, you will review the respective courses with the cyclists assigned to each race and answer any questions they have.



On race weekend, you will be the point of contact for all cyclists. Pace charts will be provided for each race. If you have a bike, a good sense of direction and great organizational skills, this role was made for you!

Participant Services- War Memorial Gym

Gym Floor Lead(s)

In this role, you will oversee all areas of the Celebration Zone including the set up for Expo on Saturday. If you are logistically sound and have experience with events you will love this position!

Bag Check Lead

In this role, you will oversee the bag check volunteers.

On race weekend, you will ensure everything is set up and that we are ready to check participants bags. If you can organize and train people for logistical tasks, then this role is perfect for you!

Info Booth Lead

In this role, you will oversee the information booth area. On race weekend, you will ensure volunteers have the correct information they need to communicate to our participants for race weekend. If you enjoy being organized and thorough as well helping people, then this will be a great role for you!

Nutrition Station Lead

In this role, you will oversee the post-race nutrition area.

On race weekend, you will ensure volunteers are trained and ready with lots of food on hand for our participants. Following the completion of the race(s), you will make sure the area is packed up. Do you have an eye for detail and the ability to organize for large crowds? Then this position is perfect for you!



Volunteer Centre Lead

In this role, you will oversee the Volunteer area.

On race weekend, you will ensure your team are giving the volunteers their supplies for their respective roles. Following the completion of the race(s), you will make sure the area is packed up. If you are people oriented, like busy environments, and know how to stay on top of things, this role is perfect for you!

Merchandise Booth Lead

In this role, you will oversee our Valley Harvest Merch Booth. You will help with the setup, display, and selling of our previous Valley Harvest Swag. You will be responsible for managing transactions (cash & card), organizing inventory, engaging with participants, volunteers and spectators, and ensuring a seamless shopping experience!

Marketing and Communications- Wolfville

Community Outreach Lead

In this role, you will oversee the communication of our event to the community. This involves organizing volunteers to walk the routes of the race over the course of a week and hand out notices to residents and businesses along the way.

Lace up your shoes as this lead position logs a few KMs! If you are organized, geographically inclined, and love getting out in the community, then this position is perfect for you.
